

Fill us with compassion for all those around us.


Unite us in solidarity as seekers of truth, sharers of faith, and recipients of your love passed down through all generations.

Through Christ our Lord, Amen.




Church


- We have an obligation to respond

Church

- A total ban on assault weapons
- Measures that control the sale and use of firearms
- Limitations on civilian access to highcapacity weapons
- A federal law to criminalize gun trafficking;
- Improved access for mental health care
- Regulations on the purchasing of handguns;
- Measures that make guns safer
- An honest assessment of the toll of yiolent images and experiences which mundate people, particularly our youth.




