BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Food and drink are given to us as signs of God's love and care. We are often spiritually hungry and thirsty but don't know how to satisfy our emptiness. In the dryness of our lives, Jesus is present to feed and nourish us. Together we dine in God's kingdom of unity and love.

"Do this in remembrance of me," Jesus commanded us on the night before he died. We "do this" when we break the bread and pour the wine. We "do this" when we share our love and possessions with those in need. At the table of the king of peace, we who are the Body of Christ, encounter him in bread and wine and in human flesh and blood.

Sometimes we refuse to share the gifts we have received with those who have none. Then the body that should be one is divided and communion is not possible. "Why don't you feed them?" Jesus asks. We say, "we have nothing," when in reality we have everything in the presence of the Lord. Jesus looks at our closed hands, and then he looks to the giving God of the universe. When we open our hands, our meager offerings are blessed and multiplied. In the breaking of the bread, there is more than enough for all.

In what ways do I experience the Body and Blood of the Lord? Do I share what I have with others?

FAMILY FAITH SHARING: We encourage parents to reflect on these questions at home each week with their children and family. Start talking. Share your faith!

Today's gospel fits our feast well. Luke tells us about the time Jesus fed the crowd with five loaves and two fish. The miracle of the loaves and fishes foreshadowed the most wonderful miracle of all. In the Eucharist, Jesus feeds as many as come to His table. There is enough food for the whole world.

How does Jesus "feed" you? How do you "feed" others?

PRAY FOR PEACE: There is a movement being organized to pray for peace. Each evening at 6 pm Pacific Time, stop whatever you are doing and spend one minute praying for peace. Peace for our world and especially for the United States and Iraq. Someone said, if Christians really understood the full extent of the power we have available through prayer, we might be speechless. Our prayer is the most powerful asset we have.
