FAITH FORMATION FOR CHILDREN: Sessions for children Kindergarten—8th grade will begin **Oct. 3 at 9:45 am**. This year we will have one family session each month that parents will attend with their children. Those dates will be clearly identified on the Faith Formation calendar that families will receive when they register. Registration forms will be sent to all registered parishioners via email in the next week or so, allowing you to print the forms at home to return to the parish either through the mail or in person, with formal registration taking place Sundays, Sept 12 and 19 after both masses. Forms are also available on our website under 'forms'. The cost of Faith Formation remains \$50 per family or \$65 if you have a child in Sacramental Preparation. Scholarships are available based on financial need.

Typically children entering 2nd grade spend the academic year preparing for First Reconciliation and First Communion. However, each year we usually have a child or two that are a little older. If that is the case for your child, know we will develop a plan that is appropriate for your family.
